

1. **Umberto Agnelli** (November 1, 1934 - May 27, 2004) Italian entrepreneur, CEO and Chairman of Fiat.
2. **Luchino Visconti** (November 2, 1906 - March 17, 1976) Italian writer, theatre and cinema director.
3. **Dr. Alfonso DiMino** (April 25, 1920 - November 3, 2001) Scientist and inventor. Emigrated from Sicily after WWII. His first US patent was for an automatic electronic clutch. employer promoted him from handyman job to Director of Research.
4. **Sgt. John Basilone** (November 4, 1916 - February 19, 1945) United States Marine Corps Medal of Honor recipient for his heroics at Guadalcanal and received the Navy Cross for his action at Iwo Jima during WWII.
5. **Peter Pace** (November 5, 1945 -) U.S. Marine Corps General. First marine pointed Chairman of the Joint Chief of Staff in 2005-2007.
6. **Tony Canzoneri** (November 6, 1908 - December 9, 1959) American boxer who won world championship titles in three divisions.
7. **Unification of Italy** On this date in 1860 Giuseppe Garibaldi turned Southern Italy and Sicily over to King Victor Emanuele.
8. **Luigi Giuseppe d'Ambrosio** (November 8, 1913 - April 24, 1995) Lightweight boxer known as Lou Ambers.
9. **Louis Jude Ferrigno** (November 9, 1951 -) Bodybuilder and movie and TV actor.
10. **Gerry DiNardo** (November 10, 1952 -) Former All American football player at the University Of Notre Dame. WFL head coach.
11. **Leonardo DiCaprio** (November 11, 1974 -) Award winning actor who became a "super star" when he starred in the "Titanic".
12. **Nick Stellino** (November 12, 1958 -) TV chef and author. Hosts cooking shows "Cucina Amore" and "Nick Stellino's Family Kitchen".
13. **Vincent Frank Testaverde** (November 13, 1963 -) American football quarterback Heisman Trophy winner. He holds the NFL records for: 1) having thrown a touchdown pass in 21 consecutive seasons and 2) interceptions in 19 consecutive seasons.
14. **Aleardo Aleardi** (November 14, 1812 - July 17, 1878) Italian Neo-romantic poet. Born Gaetano Maria.
15. **Beverly D'Angelo** (November 15, 1951 -) American singer and actress.
16. **Corporal Anthony Casamento** (November 16, 1920 - July 18, 1987) U.S. Marine Corps Cpl. Casamento was presented the Medal of Honor by President Jimmy Carter on September 12, 1980. Thirty-eight years after he'd fought gallantly on Guadalcanal in 1942.
17. **Bob Gaudio** (November 17, 1942 -) American singer/songwriter and record producer. He and Frankie Valli formed the Four Seasons.
18. **Brenda Buell Vaccaro** (November 18, 1939 -) Award winning stage, television, and film actress.
19. **Louis Rocco** (November 19, 1938 - October 31, 2002) US Army Chief Warrant Officer awarded Medal of Honor for service in Vietnam.
20. **John N. LaCorte** (July 4, 1910 - November 20, 1991) Founder of the Italian Historical Society, motto "Inspiration through Example".
21. **Joseph Campanella** (November 21, 1935 -) Actor appearing in over 200 TV and film roles since 1955.
22. **Mark Alan Ruffalo** (November 22, 1967 -) Actor of film and stage.
23. **Judge Frank Caprio** (November 23, 1936 -) Television judge on ABC. Now, sixth term Chief Judge of Providence Municipal Court.
24. **George Richard Moscone** (November 24, 1929 - November 27, 1978) 37th Mayor of San Francisco.
25. **Joe DiMaggio** (November 25, 1914 - March 8, 1999) Entire Major League career played for the NY Yankees. He was a 3-time MVP winner and 13-time All-Star MLB and holds the record of 56 consecutive games with a hit.
26. **Amelita Galli-Curci** (November 18, 1882 - November 26, 1965) Italian operatic soprano. Considered one of the 20th Century's best.
27. **Giovanni Giorgi** (November 27, 1871 - August 19, 1950) Electrical engineer who invented the Giorgi system of measurement.
28. **Cesare - Marquis of Beccaria-Bonesana** (March 15, 1738 - November 28, 1794) Italian philosopher and politician. Founding worker in the field of criminology.
29. **Giacomo Puccini** (December 22, 1858 - November 29, 1924) Composer, best know operas: La Boheme, Tosca and Madama Butterfly.
30. **Andrea Palladio** (November 30, 1508 - August 19, 1580) Italian architect, designed arcades of Basilica of Vicenza and Palladian Arch.
